

## Application form associated PhD projects and doctoral researchers

The RTG 2155 *ProMoAge* offers the option to associate doctoral projects working on *ProMoAge-related topics* and funded by other sources. The application should be submitted by the principal investigator. The doctoral candidate has to fulfil the criteria of *ProMoAge* (at least 75% of the highest grade for international students and ≤ 2.0 average mark for students from German universities). He/she will have to present the project and will be interviewed by the steering committee. The decision about acceptance is made by the steering committee. The doctoral researcher will participate in all aspects of the qualification programme including conference visits. There is a maximum of one associated project per subproject. Associations of projects from non-*ProMoAge* members are possible (**limited number**). Please make sure that the complete application is submitted in one single PDF.
